

Mystic Ladakh



Day 1	Company representatives will receive you on arrival at the international airport in Delhi and take you to your hotel.
Day 2	We take you on a tour of Old and New Delhi. As we show you the sights and sounds of this buzzing city with over 17 million residents, you sample street food, visit the presidential residence and heritage monuments of Delhi.
Day 3	We take a morning flight to Leh, the capital of the ancient Buddhist kingdom of Ladakh. Leh is nestled in the Himalayas at an altitude of 11,600ft above sea level. We rest and acclimatize to the high altitude. We walk the local market and visit the Shanti stupa in the evening and enjoy the beautiful sunset.
Day 4	Post breakfast, we visit Spituk -the fortress like monastery built in the 15th century. Post lunch we visit the Sankar monastery, located at a distance of approximately 3 km from the town of Leh. We also visit the Leh Palace, which is one of the most captivating architectural ruins that attracts the attention of the tourists almost immediately with its majestic setting at the edge of the Namgyal hill overlooking the town. This is like a reminiscent of Lhasa's Potala Palace (The chief residence of the Buddhist spiritual leader of Tibet, The Dalai Lama).
Day 5	We take a 2 hour drive on the Leh-Kargil road. En route, we visit Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, the holy shrine of the Sikh religion. Later we cross the gravity defying magnetic hill and head onwards to visit the Likir monastery and Ladakh's most loved monastery at Alchi. After visiting Alchi, we drive to Uleytokpo at our Campsite for overnight stay.
Day 6	Post early breakfast, we drive further for 2 hours, to visit the 800 year old Lamayuru monastery. After visiting Lamayuru we drive back to Leh (4 hours). En route visiting Rizong Monastery, known as the paradise for Meditation.
Day 7	After an early breakfast we drive to Nubra Valley (6 hours). The road passes through Khardung La (the highest motorable road in the world) at 18,390 ft. Nubra Valley is situated to the North of Ladakh between the Karakoram and Ladakh ranges of the Himalayas and is situated around the Shyok river basin at an average altitude of 10,000ft. We take the rest of the day at leisure to explore the beautiful village of Hundar. En route, we visit the ancient Diskit Monastery. Overnight, we stay at the camp situated amongst lush green willow and apricot trees.
Day 8	We visit the Sand Dunes of Nubra to enjoy a camel safari. Later we drive to Leh by the same route crossing Khardung La. Rest of the day at leisure to enjoy the local Ladakhi culture.

Day 9	After an early breakfast we leave for Pangong Lake (6 hours). En route we visit Shey Palace, The ancient capital of Ladakh & Thiksey, an impressive monastery rising tier upon tier on a hill above the village. We carry on further towards Pangong through Changla pass at an altitude of 5360 m (17590 ft) above sea level. Chang La is the third highest motorable road in the world. Pangong is a salt water lake and is situated at 14,000 ft. above sea level. It spans a total of 155 kms partly in India and partly in China. Overnight, we stay at camp on the lake shore.
Day 10	Morning at leisure to explore the beauty of the lake and later we drive back to Leh. En route we visit Hemis monastery, one of the key Monastic foundations of Tibetan Buddhism.
Day 11	We fly back to Delhi.
