

Northern Delight



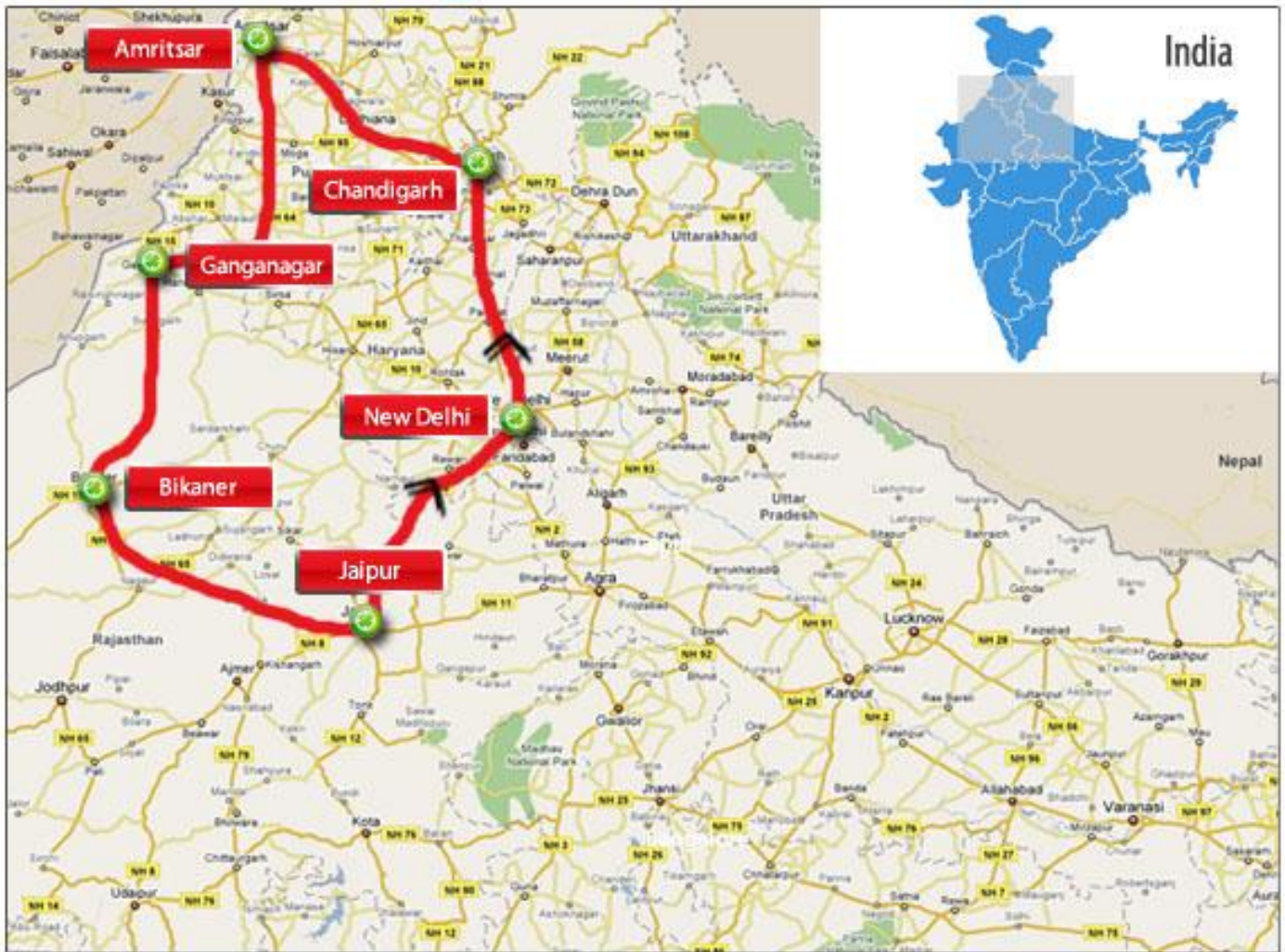
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| Day 1 | Company representatives will receive you on arrival at the International airport in Delhi and take you to your hotel. |
| Day 2 | We take you on a tour of Old and New Delhi. As we show you the sights and sounds of this buzzing city with over 17 million residents, you sample street food as well as fine dining in the best restaurants the city has to offer. |
| Day 3 | We travel from Delhi to Chandigarh by road which takes around 5 hours and settle down in the serene environment of the newest city in India. We spend the evening visiting the Sukhna Lake and key shopping areas of the city. |
| Day 4 | We tour the city of Chandigarh which is not only known for its beautiful planned streets but also its own artificial lake, rose garden, a one of a kind rock garden and many restaurants dishing out a multitude of flavors. |
| Day 5 | We travel from Chandigarh to the holy city of Amritsar by road. This trip through the most fertile plains of North India takes us 7 hours. In the evening, we dine with a traditional Sikh family and you get a taste of local Punjabi food. |
| Day 6 | We take you to the Golden Temple which is the holiest shrine of the Sikh religion. To India's 20 million Sikh residents, the Golden Temple is a unique symbol of faith, beauty and peace. It is estimated that more than 100,000 people visit the Golden Temple every week making it a more visited site than the Taj Mahal. In the evening, we visit the city markets and dine in one of the many well known local hot spots. |
| Day 7 | From Amritsar, we take you by road to Sri Ganganagar, the northernmost city of Rajasthan. Here we stay the night in a farmhouse away from the hustle and bustle of the city and dine with the locals. One look at the night sky in this place is enough for you to understand why our ancestors were perpetually mesmerized by the stars. |
| Day 8 | We travel by road to Bikaner which is also known as India's snack capital. The drive takes about 4 hours. Almost all major brands of Snacks and savories in North India have a connection to this city. Bikaner is located in the center of the Thar desert and we spend the evening looking at the sunset over the timeless dunes. |
| Day 9 | From Bikaner we take about 4 hours to reach Jaipur, also known as the Pink city. We spend the evening exploring Jaipur city. |



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| Day 10 | Jaipur was the first planned city of India and was founded on 18 th November 1727 and boasts many forts, palaces and world heritage sights. On this day, we take a royal elephant ride and visit the Amer fort, followed by visits to the Birla temple and Nahargarh fort. Here you sample true Rajasthani cuisine and get a taste of why Rajasthan is called the land of chilies. |
| Day 11 | We take a 4 hour drive back to Delhi from where you take your flight back to your respective destinations. |
